Submission Guidelines

- Each PAEA member/art teacher may send 3 works of student art.
- The submitting teacher must be a current PAEA/NAEA member.
- Students are NOT required to be members of NAHS, JNHS, or PA Art Club to submit artworks. If students are members of the NAHS, JNAHS or PA Art Club, please indicate the *chapter code* on the entry form so the work can be highlighted with a special sticker.
- Attach to each work of art: 1) completed Entry Form and 2) a completed and typed YAM show label. The upper half of the entry form should be securely attached to the back of the work and the lower half should be unattached. Information should be PRINTED in spaces provided. Parent or guardian signature is required online (instructions below on pages 2 and 3 of this packet). Artwork without an entry form or missing permissions will not be exhibited. All artwork must include a YAM show fillable label that is **typed** by the submitting teacher. Please fill in the blanks of the YAM Label PDF Form by typing on the computer, print, and attach to the bottom right hand corner of the mat. Unlabeled work will not be hung. Leave no blanks empty on the YAM show label.
- Enclose with your artwork submissions, the duplicate half-sheet of the YAM show labels, automatically filled in, for our record keeping and organization. The duplicate half sheet of labels is our record of your submissions.
- 2-D work only. Individual work should not exceed: 30" x 40".
- All works MUST be unframed, matted/mounted/secured with at least a two inch border using mounting board the weight of railroad board or heavier. Corrugated cardboard is okay. DO NOT mount on construction paper alone. DO NOT use hinged or double mounted mats. Framed art, work with glass, heavy stretchers, etc. cannot be accommodated and will NOT be hung.
- All works WILL be hung with thumb tacks and T-pins. Work cannot be hung with nails or picture hooks. We will try our best to use a minimal amount of tack holes. Please do not send fragile work.
- Due to limited exhibition space, only 2-D work will be accepted. Drawings, prints, photographs, collage, paintings on canvas board, and watercolors are all acceptable. Charcoal and pastel works should be under acetate. DO NOT SEND 3-D work, sculpture, or works of crafts, jewelry, etc. You may send photographs of 3-D work that meet above presentation criteria.
- **Each teacher that would like student art returned by mail should enclose a return mailing label and a \$5.00 contribution for the postage. You may send cash or check made payable to PAEA.**

ANY WORK OF ART THAT DOES NOT HAVE COMPLETED ENTRY FORM, YAM LABEL, DOES NOT COMPLY WITH CRITERIA AND REGULATIONS, OR DOES NOT HAVE A PARENT OR GUARDIAN PERMISSION, WILL NOT BE EXHIBITED.

Checklist

Before sending each artwork:

- photograph the work and follow instructions to submit a digital copy (see page 2)
- send parent letter home to secure permission to exhibit via online form (see page 3)

Attach to each artwork:

- completed (typed) YAM show label (cut apart and attached to front side, bottom right)

Include with your submission:

- duplicate half sheet of YAM show labels as a record of inventory
- enclose a return postage paid letter size envelope for return

Delivery of Student Work

All work should be delivered or mailed to your PAEA regional YAM show representative. Submissions **MUST** be received by your PAEA Representative on or before: **Friday, February 9, 2018.**

Submission Guidelines

- Submit labeled photographed Student Work by Friday, February 9, 2018.
- The image size should ideally be 1920x1080 px. 72 ppi resolution.
- Submissions will be accepted even if you cannot format to these dimensions.

To Enter: Easy as 1, 2, 3

1. Teacher: Prepare the Work

- Use Pixlr.com/editor to ensure the correct text format your entries.
- Works submitted without this label will not be exhibited.
- Go to Pixlr.com/editor

Click "Open Image From Computer"

Choose your image and open it.

Click on the "A" (Insert Text) on the left side toolbar

Format for Label:

Student First Name, Last Name

Grade #

School District

Verdana Font

Font color > White

Style: Bold the text

Click "OK"

Right justify the text

Use the arrow tool to drag the text box

Export the labeled photograph

File > Save

Very Important!

Name the file with the student's last name underscore first initial ex.

"smith_j.jpg"

Click "OK"

- Locate this new file in your downloads.
- Note: Files must not exceed 10 MB - Compress your file if needed using a photo editing program

Then send your student work to the appropriate regional representative at the address below.

Check List Before Sending Work

- Photograph student artwork, label the photo and submit to online dropbox.
- Email permission note or print and send home.
- Completed entry form with parent signature and upper half of form securely attached to the back side of the art
- Completed & typed YAM show label cut and attached to the front and bottom right side of the student art.
- Duplicate half-sheet of YAM show labels as a record of inventory included with your submission.
- \$5 check or cash per package for return postage if you wish to have the student art returned by mail.
